(Revelation 5:5).

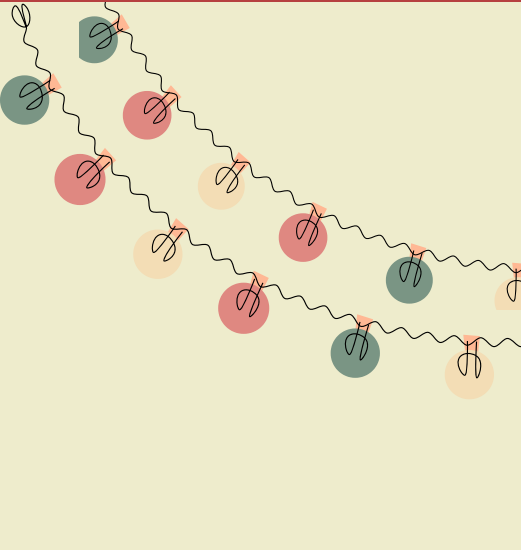
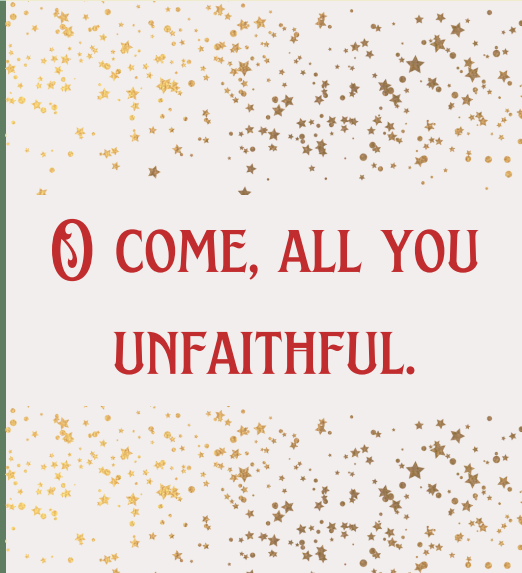
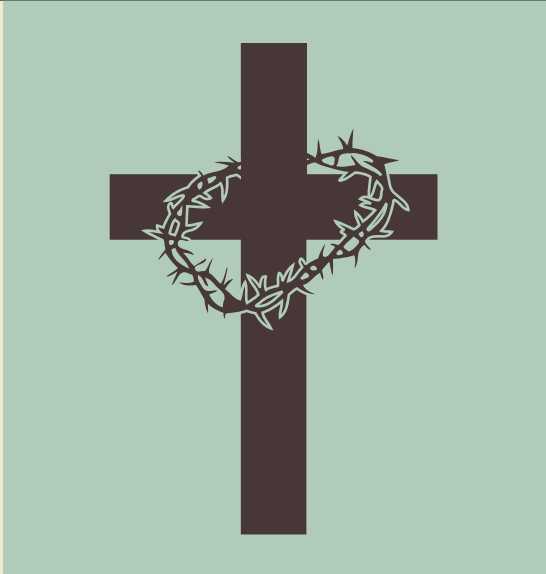
He was despised and rejected
